INDIVIDUAL EVENT ONLINE CHAMPIONSHIP

What is it?

- ❑ An online competition searching for the Best Cheer & Dance Athletes.
- ❑ Judged by our own professional staff of cheer and dance judges and fan votes (25% fan votes and 75% judging panel).
- ❑ Fan vote will be based on a rating system from 1 to 10 (10 being the best).
- ❑ Cost: \$50 per person per event.

How can I participate?

- ❑ No pre qualification.
- ❑ You must represent an All-Star, School, Studio, Recreation or Youth League Program. Coaches can enter in the Open or Pro-Open division.
- ❑ Record your individual routine (you may use any type of video recording device including the video camera on your iphone or other cellular devices).
 - Beginning of video should be a creative introduction and must include your name, program, age division and event. Introduction cannot exceed 15 seconds.
- ❑ Competition videos will be accepted; however, they must also include the required introduction.

- ❑ Registration Form (2 ways to register):
 - Online registration available (including credit card information for payment)
 - Fax registration form to 281-339-2976
 - Videos will not be posted until registration and payment is received and processed.

When are the dates of the competition?

- ❑ Winter Competition Dates: December 1, 2011 through January 31, 2012
- ❑ Spring Competition Dates: February 15, 2012 through April 15, 2012
- ❑ Summer Competition Dates: June 1, 2012 through August 1, 2012
- ❑ All videos must be received 1 week prior to ending date of each Competition.

What do I win?

- ❑ Every participant will receive an Individual Placement Plaque.
- ❑ **Champions** in each division will receive:
 - Individual Champion Plaque
 - Featured on cheerpower.varsity.com
 - Bid to Nation's Best Individual Championship in Las Vegas on May 19-20, 2012 (Summer Competition Champions will receive a bid to the 2013 Nation's Best Individual Championship).
- ❑ **Highest Score:** The Individual Event (solo or group) with the highest combined score at the end of each time frame will win:
 - A paid bid to compete in their winning event at the Nation's Best Individual Championship in Las Vegas on May 19-20, 2012 (Summer Competition winner will receive a paid bid to the 2013 Nation's Best Individual Championship).
 - National Champion Jacket.
 - Featured in American Cheerleader Magazine.

What are the Rules?

- ❑ Must follow Cheer Power and Power Dance Individual Event Guidelines and Restrictions.
- ❑ Must follow Cheer Power and Power Dance Individual Event Age Divisions. Age is determined as of August 31, 2011.
- ❑ All individuals will compete together by age and event.
- ❑ Cheer Power/Power Dance has the right to combine or separate divisions based on number of entries.
- ❑ Payment and registration must be received before your video is posted.
